

AUSTIN



AUSTIN is an early to medium early processing potato which has an excellent suitability for the production of crisps. The low content of reducing sugars makes it perfect for long term storage.

Some interesting facts about AUSTIN:

- Rapid early growth
- Presprouted and under foil early harvest possible
- Good tolerance for periods of drought and heat
- Resistance against Y-virus
- Resistance against nematodes Ro1, 4 (9) and wart disease 1 (10), 6 (slightly susceptible)
- Consistent under water weight



MATURITY:	early to medium early
TUBER SHAPE:	Round-oval, rather shallow eyes, light yellow flesh color
PROCESSING:	Excellent suitability for crisps production, very low content of acrylamide even after long term storage
YIELD:	high; high dry matter content
